We have bedded down a new executive team. The states reps I believe are doing a great job in each of their areas, all do far more than the average member realises, and it is due to them that the great regional shows held this year were such a success. I would also like to welcome Angus Barlow as a new vice president and Sonya Ford as Victorian State Representative to the management team.

In an attempt to encourage new breeders and children we have put in place a development office, and I would like to thank Judy Ann Mills for taking on this important role.

The auction was a big success, Martin will provide the details. But what we proved that whilst it was a bit of work we need to have phone bidding to engage outside interest to make this work. Thanks to all for their generous donations.

What is ahead for 2019-2020?

These will be a limited Edition of 20, so this should be a big fund raiser for the club. The regionals will run as in 2019, but we will be holding our National Show at Sydney in conjunction with Poultry 2020. So a great show program is at hand for 2020.

The other work in progress is putting together a Judges panel, to try and improve the consistency in Judging we need in the breed. This is a work in progress and has been kicked around by our secretary Martin for some years. So hopefully we can get this put together over the course of the next 12 months

In finishing this year what has been pleasing to see is that the Orpingtons are back at the Royal Shows. At every Royal on the mainland we had big Orpingtons to the forefront of the poultry and non-poultry world. Showing at the Royals is often not easy but thankyou to all who made the effort.

It would be remiss of me not to mention outgoing Vice President Judy Witney for her services to the Orpington Club of Australia. Her love of the Buff Orpington is second to none, thankyou Judy.

I was recently asked a question by a new younger member this year "what do I get from the Orpington Club?" Possibly a fair question you pay memberships so everyone is entitled to a return. Once in a Life Time Opportunity..... To Obtain Your Piece of Orpington History

As you are aware the Orpington Club commissioned acclaimed artist Sharon Eversol to paint a standard painting of the Ideal Orpington to complement the written breed standards contained in the Australian poultry Standards. This picture was launched early this year to widely held acclaim across the poultry fancy domestically and internationally.

As a result the Orpington Club of Australia has produced a limited offer of 20 prints signed by the artist. These are a limited offer which have been signed 1/20, 2/20, 3/20 through to 20/20 and represent an amazing opportunity to own a piece of Orpington history as well as raise funds for the Club.

Print 1/20 will be auctioned as single lot through an online process via the Club Facebook site on Sunday 1st December 2019 which will be similar to a Helmsman style auction commencing at 6.00pm AEDST and run until 7.00pm AEDST.

Prints 2/20 through to print 10/20 will be auctioned as individual lots through the Club Facebook site on Monday 2nd December 2019 from 6.00pm AEDST with a lag time of 1 hour and 1 minute between each lot.

For instance Lot 2 for print 2/20 will finish at 7.02pm AEDST lot 3 (print 3/20) will finish at 7.03pm AEDST and so on until lot 10 (print 10/20) finishes at 7.10pm AEDST.

Minimum starting bid for Lot 1 (Print 1/20) will be AUD \$100.

There is NO RESERVE for lots 2/20 to 10/20.

If the Lot auction finishes at say 7.00pm only bids before 7.00pm and on 7.00pm will be accepted. Any bid made at 7.01pm will not be accepted.

Minimum bid increments for all lots will be \$5.00.

Administration of the auction will be with the Club Secretary Martin Doulton (Wananga Orpingtons) who is not bidding for any of these lots. The Admin decision on all auction lots will be FINAL. The winning bidder for each lot will be contacted by admin to confirm their success, payment and delivery details.

All payments must be made in Australian Dollars within 24hrs of the auction finishing via the Clubs bank account or paypal account. Lots will be posted within 48hrs of payment being made. Each print is unframed and will be sent in a postage scroll to prevent damage. Postage anywhere in the world is included in the auction bid.

2. Minutes from 2018 AGM held at Harden PC NSW on 30th June 2018

a. Presidents Report- as circulated in May 2018 AGM Outlook (1)

b. Secretary's Report- as circulated in May 2018 AGM Outlook (2)

c. Financial Report- as circulated in May 2018 AGM Outlook (3) Read out by R.Gibson Moved C.Hardman Seconded. Mrs.M.Gavenlock

Motion that the President's and Secretary's Reports be accepted. Moved Mrs N.Hobson, Seconded R.Callinan

Approved.

5. Election of Officers – R.Gibson handed the Chair to R.Callinan to declare nominations.

Motion to appoint Executive and Office Bearers en bloc as per attached list. Proposed by Mrs M.Gavenlock Seconded. Mrs J.Stannard.

Approved.

R.Gibson re-took the Chair as President and asked for vote on Vice President positions as there were 3 nominations. A silent ballot was run, and numbers were counted.

R.Gibson declared vote in favour of Dennis Stannard, and Angus Barlow.

R.Gibson mentioned Jenny Stewarts work over the years and suggested that a gift in appreciation of her work be given.

6. Any Other Business

a. Setting of Annual membership Fees for 2019-20.

i. That the Membership fees to remain at \$20 (Junior =\$10) for the 2019-20 Year.

Moved. R.Gibson Seconded C.Hardman. Approved.

b. D.Stannard proposed a Vote of Thanks be recorded for the significant contributions made by Judy Witney. R.Gibson added that a gift as a token of appreciation be given.

- c. 2020 National Show Venue- The meeting was updated that the EPA National Show is on in Sydney in 2020. R.Callinan suggested that there would be a bigger public audience for the breed in Sydney. There was a general discussion of the costs and that there would be no opportunity to run a auction with funds going to the Club. R.Gibson advised that there would be another chance of fund raising for the Club through online auction of limited edition prints of the birds from the new logo and that the President and Secretary are both in favour of the Club National being held at the EPA National. It was mentioned what would happen if a non-number won one of the trophies – that the trophies would not be in the non-members possession. R.Callinan mentioned how good the Orpington Club of Australia is and that it is considered one of the best Orpington clubs in the world. He suggested that members take the risk and be progressive and join in with the National Poultry Show for 2020. D.Stannard mentioned that being involved with the EPA National Show can be expensive, as pen fees are dearer and that the Club would have to pay travel & accommodation costs or the judges. C.Hardman asked about judges for Sydney and R.Gibson advised that nominations had actually already closed and that a few members suggested Duane Rhall. R.Gibson asked for a show of hands in favour of Sydney – most members in agreeance that the 2020 National Orpington Show be held at the National Poultry Show in Sydney 5-8th June 2020.
- d. State Representatives were announced, no election is required under the constitution. As follows:
NSW – Megan Gavenlock
Vic – Vacant (was being filled by Trevor Dent)
SA – Trevor Dent
Qld – Karen Bussian
WA – Cliff Weichelt
M.Gavenlock suggested that as Trevor probably has enough to do with SA, she would like to nominate Sonya Ford for the Victorian representative. Sonya was asked if she was happy to accept, which she agreed.
- e. R.Gibson thanked Megan Gavenlock, Karen Bussian, Suzanne Knight, and Jayne Stannard – otherwise known as the 4 “Charlie’s Angels” for all their work on the Club Show.
- f. R.Gibson expressed his thanks for Martin Doulton and all his work for the Club.
- g. R.Gibson thanked Blue and Pam Callinan for attending our show.
- h. S.Ford mentioned Meg Miller OAM for her services to the poultry fanciers industry. R.Gibson also mentioned her work for the new Club logo. Motion that a letter of thanks be sent to Meg. Moved S.Ford, Seconded N.Hobson
- i. R.Gibson advised that the Executive talk via phone hook-ups every 6 weeks.
- j. R.Gibson said that when Martin returns that work will be started for the Auction of the limited edition prints with Angus Barlow’s assistance. A.Barlow suggested selling through Auctions Plus, however, that could be expensive. C.Hardman suggested auctioning on Club Facebook page. Another suggestion was selling on eBay.
- k. R.Gibson thanked Dallas Smith for his input into developing the new logo, and moved that a letter of thanks be sent to Dallas. Moved R.Gibson Seconded R.Callinan
- l. R.Gibson moved a vote of thanks to Chris Hardman for the new award cards. Moved K.Bussian Seconded M.Gavenlock
- m. J.Stannard expressed concern that two signatories should be required to sign for the Club’s bank account, and that this will be rectified ASAP. Three should be available with 2 to sign.
- n. A brief discussion was had on encouraging more junior members into the Club and that maybe a joining package be given on joining the Club. R.Gibson asked Duane Rhall on junior membership and numbers in the Wyandotte Club, and he replied that it wasn’t much better. S. Venator suggested that a package should also be given to new novice members. J.Stannard mentioned that at most shows, juniors are not eligible to go onto win the BOS although we

allow and maybe this should be promoted more. How do we get more juniors? R.Gibson suggested that we set some schools up with some trios. D.Rhall said that there is now a poultry keeping subject in Year 7. If a school enters Orpingtons in a show, then a Certificate could be given. Also a new section in the newsletter for schools, with schools sending photos and results to include. A Junior Development Officer position should be made – Julie-Ann Mills nominated. Moved M.Gavenlock Seconded S. Venator.

- o. J.McKeown mentioned that a small item/gift for anyone joining the Club such as a badge or discount on book purchase. R.Gibson suggested value to \$10 and asked for show of hands, most in favour no against. Moved J.McKeown Seconded S.Knight
- p. R.Daley suggested more articles to be included in the Newsletter such as breeder profiles, State happenings, poultry information.
- q. C.Hardman suggested a list of judges be created and nominated Trevor Dent and Bradley O’Leary to be added.
